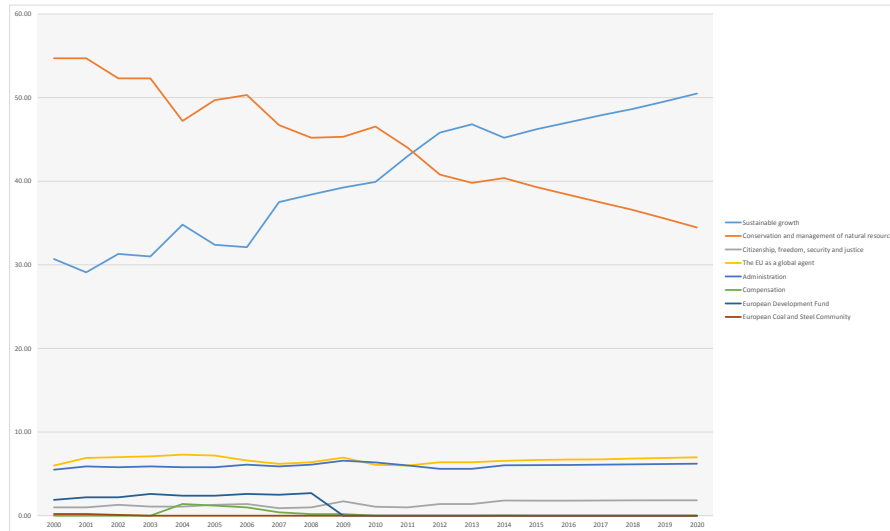

Principales partidas del presupuesto comunitario	
Sustainable growth	Competitiveness for growth and employment: costs related to research and innovation (Framework Programmes), education and training, EU networks, social policy, the internal market and associated policies.
Conservation and management of natural resources	Cohesion for growth and employment: this is supported by Cohesion and Structural Funds. The objective is to reduce regional disparities and to favour regional development.
Citizenship, freedom, security and justice	This item covers the Common Agricultural Policy, the Common Fisheries Policy, rural development and environmental measures.
The EU as a global agent	Freedom, security and justice: an item dedicated to justice and home affairs, to the protection of borders and to immigration and asylum policy.
Administration	Citizenship: this covers public health spending, consumer protection, culture, youth, information and dialogue with citizens.
Compensation	Expenses relating to the external action of the EU (cooperation for development, humanitarian aid, Foreign Policy and Common Security, European Neighbourhood Policy and expenses relating to pre-adhesion).
European Development Fund	Expenses associated with the workings of the European institutions.
European Coal and Steel Community	Budget items destined for the compensation of some member countries, awarded in specific conditions which do not appear every year.
